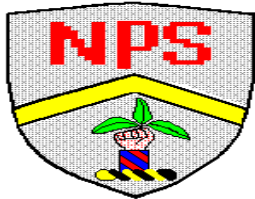

Football Strip Competition

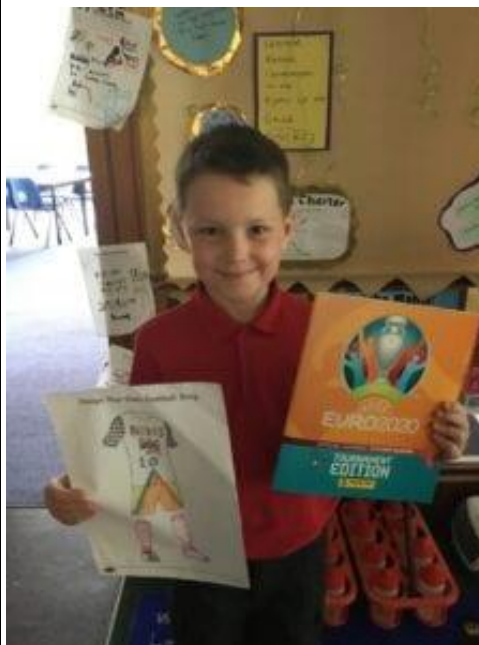
